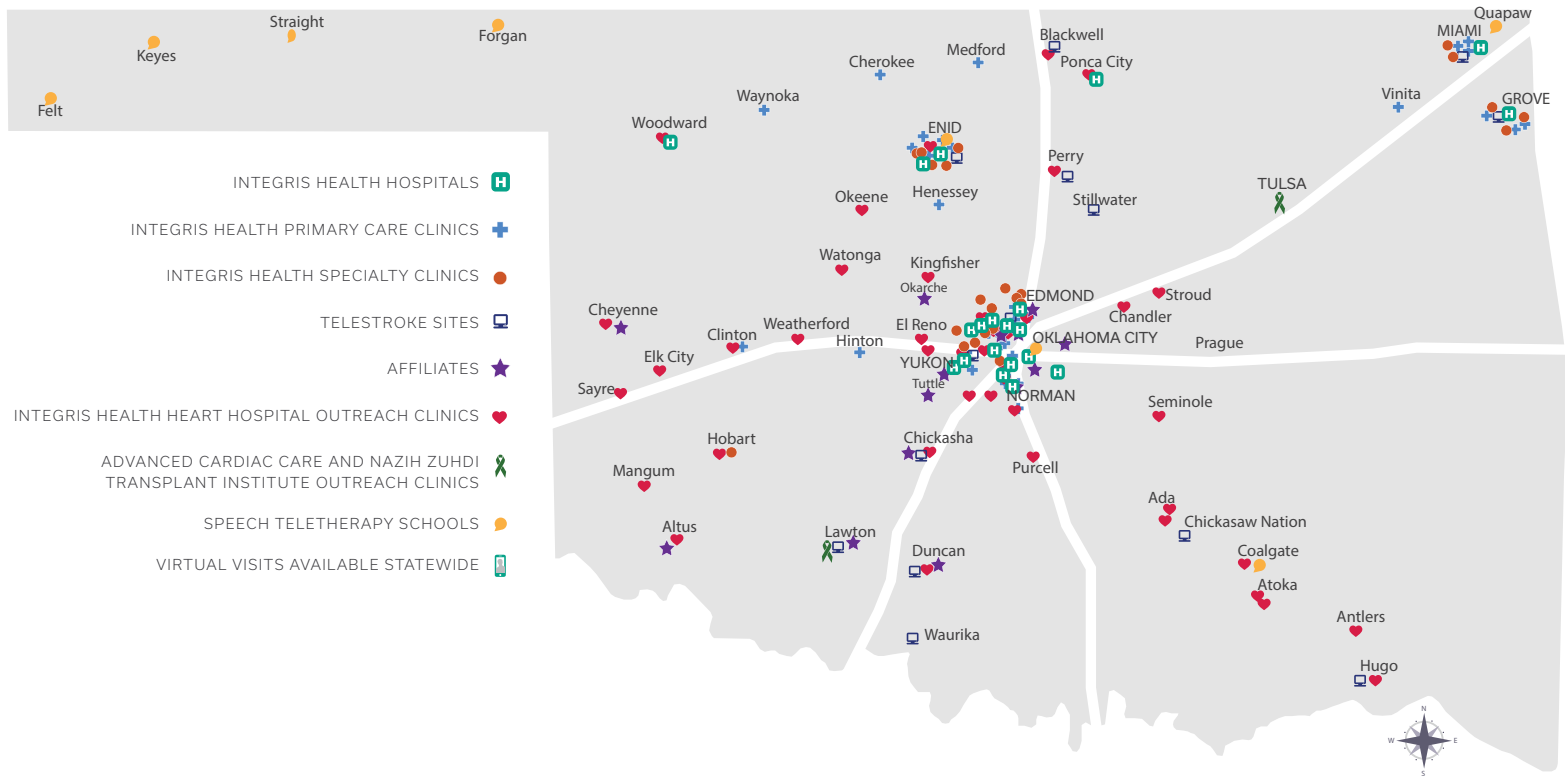

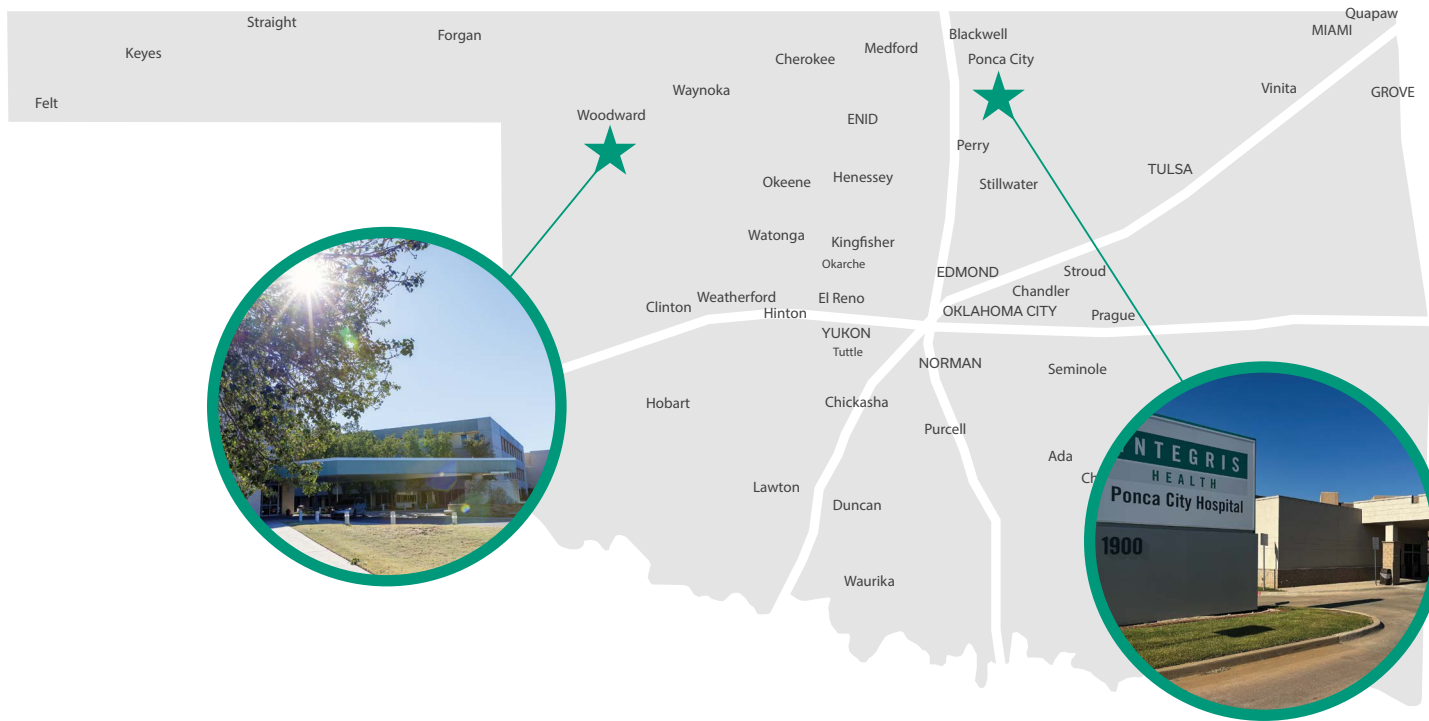

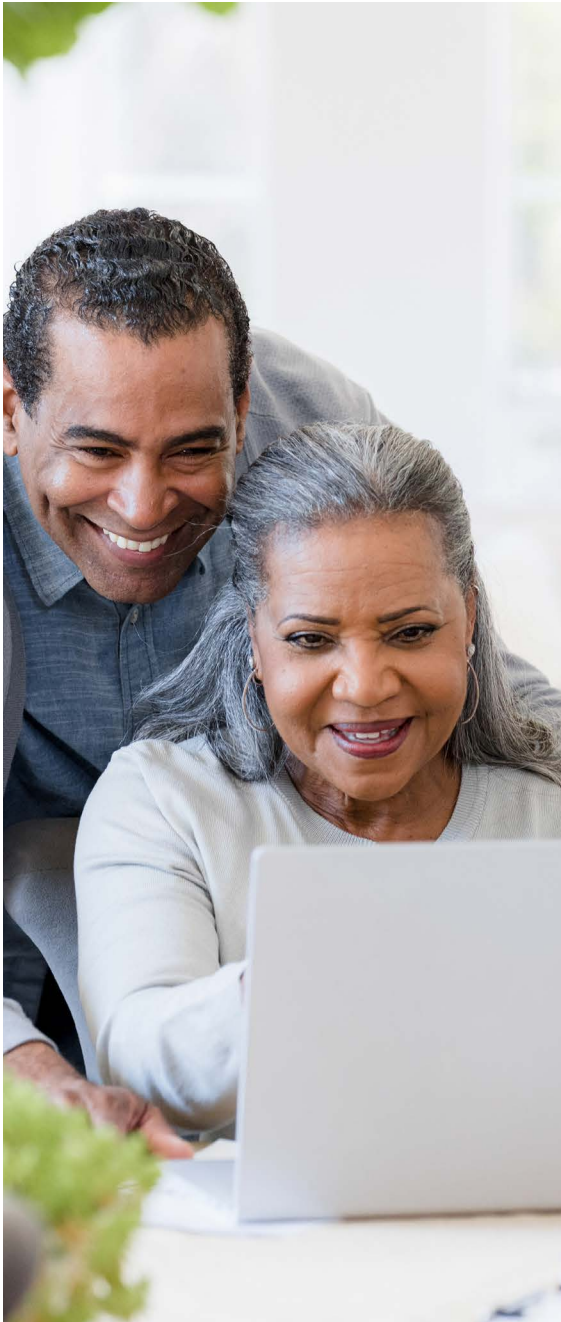

Serving our community

INTEGRIS Health's mission is partnering with people to live healthier lives. As Oklahoma's largest not-for-profit community health system, INTEGRIS Health has long served this mission through innovative and transformative community health programs. We learned a long time ago that we can't fully care for our community by staying exclusively within the walls of our facilities.

What is community impact?

At INTEGRIS Health, the physicians, staff and volunteers take their education and skills into the community to make a difference in the lives of their fellow Oklahomans. They provide free clinical services, health screenings and educational programs. They further positively impact our communities by providing access to healthy food and tobacco cessation services. Their dedication, combined with our resources, helps accomplish a variety of things – from providing free clinical services, screenings and education programs to providing greater access to healthy food and tobacco cessation services.

We also realize that the health of a community isn't just physical and mental, it's economic and spiritual as well. That's why we offer a myriad of programs that address all of these important issues.



INTEGRIS Health Enid Hospital Drug Take Back Day

Program/Project Overview:

INTEGRIS Health Enid Hospital partnered with the Oklahoma Bureau of Narcotics to host a drug take back day in conjunction with the National Prescription Drug Take Back Day to help make homes safe. Unused or expired prescription medications are a public safety issue, leading to accidental poisoning, overdose and abuse.

Highlights:

513 vials and boxes of medication were returned, totaling 32 lbs.

Partnerships:

The Blood Institute and Coffee Inclination were on site. Community members were able to donate blood and treat themselves to coffee while dropping off their medications.

INTEGRIS Health Grove Hospital Souper Bowl Saturday

Program/Project Overview:

The Volunteers at the hospital organize this yearly fundraiser event, where attendees can receive health screenings and enjoy an assortment of soups while they enjoy local entertainment throughout the afternoon.

Highlights:

This yearly event highlights the work of our INTEGRIS Health Grove Hospital volunteers. It also benefits the Grove community by providing free health screenings, keeping alive our mission to partner with people to live healthier lives. One hundred eighty attendees received health screenings.

INTEGRIS Health Community Clinic

Program/Project Overview:

In January 1993, INTEGRIS Health opened the INTEGRIS Health Community Clinic, a free medical clinic in Oklahoma City. The clinic is staffed by INTEGRIS Health caregivers and offers free medical care to low-income, uninsured and underinsured populations. The clinic offers adult care of chronic diseases, on-site pharmacy, diabetes education classes, physical, occupation and speech therapies, vision services and fresh produce distribution for food insecure families.

Highlights:

INTEGRIS Health, in partnership with the Health Alliance for the Uninsured, provides patients with free medications to manage acute and chronic health conditions using the prescription assistance program. The Health Alliance for the Uninsured is a hub of support for the Safety Net Clinic Network and provides the INTEGRIS Health Community Clinic and 94 other clinics statewide with supplies, information, trainings and a referral network.

INTEGRIS Health Hispanic Health Fair

Program/Project Overview:

Celebrating its 33rd anniversary, the Hispanic Health Fair is the largest free fair in Oklahoma and an important strategic outreach in the INTEGRIS Health mission:

“Partnering with people to live healthier lives.”

Highlights:

The Hispanic Health Fair, besides being a wonderful resource for uninsured and underinsured patients, is a reference to all other events in the city since it provides follow-up with specialists in case patients receive abnormal results in their screenings. Every year, volunteer physicians and therapists treat patients with conditions like diabetes, high cholesterol and hypertension. Assistance may also include colonoscopies, cancer treatment and surgeries by volunteer physicians and therapists. Also, this health fair is unique in the sense that it serves as a one-stop shop, bringing in resources for the community such as employment agencies, education institutions, not-for-profit organizations and financial institutions. Participants can visit, consult and take advantage of the services and products they provide.

103 partners: health systems, not-for-profit organizations, community agencies, dentists, chiropractors, schools, consulates, adult learning centers, financial organizations, social security, legal aid, faith communities, first responders, Hispanic media, etc.

INTEGRIS Health Community Health Fair

Program/Project Overview:

The INTEGRIS Health Mobile Wellness Clinic provides health services for Oklahoma County's underserved through chronic disease support, health screenings, food distribution, support groups and wellness resources.

INTEGRIS Health, in partnership with the Latino Community Development Agency and other agencies, coordinated a health fair for the Edmond community.

Highlights:

More than 100 attendees and 58 participants were screened for glucose, cholesterol, BMI, height and weight. This community health fair was a success.

INTEGRIS Health Canadian Valley Hospital Senior Center of Yukon Blood Pressure Checks

Program/Project Overview:

In 2023, INTEGRIS Health partnered with the Yukon Senior Center to provide monthly blood pressure checks for seniors.

Highlights:

During fiscal year 2023, we screened 97 participants for blood pressure and provided vital information to them about the steps to take for optimum blood pressure levels.

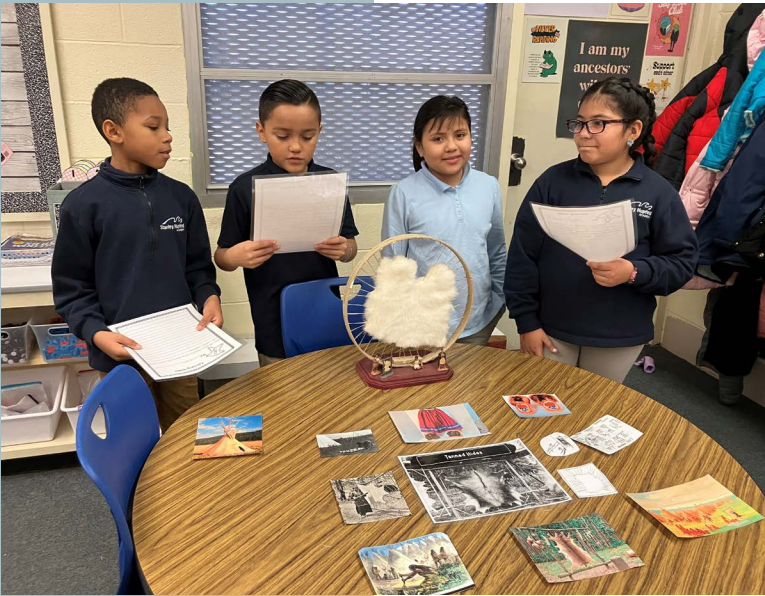
Stanley Hupfeld Academy at Western Village

Program/Project Overview:

Stanley Hupfeld Academy at Western Village is a public neighborhood elementary charter school located in Oklahoma City. The Academy offers grades Pre-K to 4th with no more than 23 students in each class. As the first charter school in the state to serve the children in its own area, it has made significant strides forward with the help of INTEGRIS Health. Stanley Hupfeld Academy has close to 100 mentors and growing and strong parental support.

Highlights:

Stanley Hupfeld Academy successes include raising their state report card from a "D-" to a "B," increasing enrollment from 150 to 330 with a waiting list, increasing student involvement in sports from 23% to 76% and a decrease in conduct referrals from 37% to 11%.





INTEGRIS Health Community Benefit Cancer Series

Program/Project Overview:

The INTEGRIS Health Cancer Series provides cancer prevention presentations on breast, prostate, skin, colon, lung and head and neck cancer. Each presentation starts with health screenings including glucose, cholesterol, blood pressure, BMI, PSA, HIV and vaccines (flu and COVID) and then a health presentation accompanied by a healthy dinner is provided for participants. A local health care professional provides cancer prevention topics.

Highlights:

Six events are held during the year. Approximately 80 participants attended and a total of 525 people were served.

2023 BENEFITS TO THE COMMUNITY BY THE NUMBERS

INTEGRIS Health provided **\$129,292,730** in community benefits. This includes our total community impact, community building efforts, uncompensated services and Medicaid services.

Total Community Impact

Total community impact epitomizes our mission of partnering with people to live healthier lives. It takes the form of hundreds of programs and acts of charity provided daily across the state of Oklahoma, such as free health screenings, support groups, medical services, educational programs and health fairs.

Our total community impact efforts equaled \$8,286,863.

Community Building

Community building is another vital way we give back. These efforts address the root causes of health problems. Some of our activities in community building are physical improvements in housing, economic development, community support, environmental enhancements and advocacy for advancements in community health.

Our community building efforts equaled \$525,016.

Uncompensated Services

Uncompensated services are the costs of providing free and reduced-cost care. As a system of not-for-profit hospitals, INTEGRIS Health provides services to everyone, regardless of the ability to pay. Thus, we provide a much-needed safety net for members of our community who would otherwise have no access to medical care. INTEGRIS Health is committed to providing medically necessary care by offering financial assistance to qualifying patients. **INTEGRIS Health provided charity care at an estimated cost of \$33,817,992.**

Bad Debt

In addition, INTEGRIS Health incurred bad debt with an estimated cost of \$68,061,850 based on the overall hospital cost-to-charge ratio.

Medicaid Services

INTEGRIS Health also provides care to patients who qualify for Medicaid programs. This includes the actual unpaid cost of providing care to Medicaid patients and represents a shortfall between cost of care and payments received by Medicaid.

INTEGRIS Health provided Medicaid services at an estimated cost of \$86,662,859.
