

What is the Medication Management Clinic?

The purpose of the IH Medication Management Clinics is to provide high touch and high-quality comprehensive medication management to patients. After a physician refers patients to the Medication Management Clinic, the Clinical Pharmacist conducts a visit, either remotely or in-person. This visit includes, but is not limited to, a full medication history reconciliation, identification of adherence or cost barriers, titration of medications, and institution of formulary changes if required by the patient's insurance. This service is offered free of cost to promote continuity of care.

Collaborative Practice Agreements

For a Medication Management Clinical Pharmacist to see your patients, the physician¹ and the pharmacists must enter into a Collaborative Practice Agreement. Process:

Providers that utilize INTEGRIS Health's Epic medical record

1. Provider initiates an Ambulatory Referral to Medication Management in Epic.
2. The Medication Management staff schedules the patient for a visit.
3. The Medication Management Pharmacist conducts the visit with the patient, adjusts medications if needed in accordance with the collaborative practice agreement, and schedules appropriate follow-up visits.
4. The Medication Management Pharmacist writes a comprehensive note in Epic and copies the provider on the note for awareness.

Clinics that utilize other electronic medical records

1. Provider initiates a faxed or securely emailed referral using the Medication Management Referral form.
2. The Medication Management staff schedules the patient for a visit.
3. The Medication Management Pharmacist conducts a visit with the patient. The Pharmacist will titrate medications appropriately but if any new prescriptions are recommended, the Pharmacist reaches out to the physician's office.
4. The Medication Management Pharmacist writes a comprehensive note documented in Epic and faxes or securely emails the provider the note for their awareness.
