 - o Automated notifications for block owners-Go Live October 2023 at pilot facilities
 - o Automated ability to request block release-Go live October 2023 at pilot facilities
- SSI prevention monitoring utilizing K Cards to monitor THA, TKA, Colon and Hysterectomy patients to ensure all measures are met. Please ensure that you are entering antibiotic orders

IACC/NZTI Update – Kay Shields Ragan

- Established Liver Transplant Hotline for urgent inpatient referral of potential liver transplants
- Physicians are meeting with ICU’s and hospital physician groups both within IH and external facilities. This hotline provides access directly to a NZTI transplant hepatologist.
- Initiating assessment in tandem with CI team to review Kidney referral to waitlist process to gain efficiencies and shorten throughput time, targeted start date in late May
- Engaging with EPIC team to review potential optimization opportunities for transplant flow

- Implemented eCPR for select patients undergoing resuscitation, initial outcomes are above nationally reported results; will reassess at 6 months to determine possibility of expanding coverage hours
- Implementing XynQAPI tool to assist with evaluation and improved tracking of transplant related quality events, currently under ITS review with vendor

APP Update

INTEGRIS Health Partners Shared Savings Eligibility

Beginning in 2024, APPs in primary care practices managing a panel of patients will be eligible for IHP shared savings.

What does this mean for you?

Traditionally, shared savings have been only available to physicians. However, recognizing the vital role APPs play in delivering comprehensive primary care, we have expanded the eligibility criteria. This change ensures that the savings generated are equitably distributed among all members of the primary care team.

How can you participate?

To be eligible for shared savings, the APP will need to work in a primary care clinic and have attribution in IHP value-based plans. APPs will also be required to complete the same IHP Metrics as physicians, which are listed for the current year at [Metrics | INTEGRIS Health \(integrisok.com\)](#). These include Lumeris CDI trainings, completion of the IHP Provider Survey, and attendance/viewing of IHP summits and pod meetings.

This change will go into effect in 2024, so completion of the metrics this year is not required, however you are welcome to access any of the available content. Stay tuned for further updates, and don't hesitate to [reach out to IHP if you have questions](#).

Coding Tip of the Month:

Dementia

The ICD-10-CM classifies dementia (categories F01, F02, and F03) based on the etiology and severity (unspecified, mild, moderate, or severe). The Selection of the appropriate severity level requires the provider's clinical judgment and codes should be assigned only based on provider documentation (as defined in the Official Guidelines for Coding and Reporting), unless otherwise instructed by the classification. If the documentation does not provide information about the severity of the dementia, assign the appropriate code for unspecified severity.

The table below shows how the code set of "Dementia in other diseases" was expanded to show the severity types of mild, moderate, severe, and unspecified based upon the providers documentation and assessment of the patient.

ICD-10 Code	ICD-10-CM Description
F02.811	Dementia in other diseases classified elsewhere, unspecified severity, with agitation
F02.A0	Dementia in other diseases classified elsewhere, mild, without behavioral disturbance, psychotic disturbance, mood disturbance, and anxiety
F02.B0	Dementia in other diseases classified elsewhere, moderate, without behavioral disturbance, psychotic disturbance, mood disturbance, and anxiety
F02.C0	Dementia in other diseases classified elsewhere, severe, without behavioral disturbance, psychotic disturbance, mood disturbance, and anxiety

Code first the underlying physiological condition, such as:

G20 Parkinson's Disease

G31.83 Lewy body dementia

Not an all-inclusive list of diagnoses and complications

Coding Vascular Dementia with the appropriate documentation.

F01.A11 – Vascular dementia, mild, with agitation – Stable, continue taking Rivastigmine as directed.

Coding Dementia with Parkinson’s as the underlying disease with the appropriate documentation.

G20 – Parkinson’s Disease, controlled, continue taking donzepil as directed.

F02.811 Dementia in other diseases, controlled, associated with Parkinson’s, continue taking medications as rx’d.

Gender Affirming Provider Survey

United Healthcare Negotiations

As most of you are aware, INTEGRIS Health has opened contract negotiations with several payors, most recently concluding new agreements with Cigna and Aetna. As of yet, INTEGRIS Health has not reached agreement with United Healthcare.

The negotiation with United Healthcare was initiated earlier this year by activating the termination without cause contract provision in order to align INTEGRIS Health and United on an effective date for a new agreement to be reached. Since we are nearing thirty days to the possible termination effective date of 12/6/23, this has activated a communication plan to our patients.

Today INTEGRIS Health proactively sent a letter to patients informing them of this negotiation and that if an agreement is not reached, INTEGRIS Health will be out-of-network with United starting 12/6/2023. Attached is a copy of the patient letter.

Dear Patient,

Our records indicate that you or a family member on a United Healthcare plan have recently received health care services from INTEGRIS Health. As a valued INTEGRIS Health patient, we want to share that we are in contract negotiations with United Healthcare.

The contract negotiations include INTEGRIS Health hospitals and ancillary services, our employed network of physicians and INTEGRIS Health joint venture partners. **If we are unable to come to a fair and reasonable agreement, INTEGRIS Health will be out-of-network with United Healthcare after December 6, 2023.**

What this means for you:

- For now, nothing has changed, and there is no need to reschedule appointments. You still have in-network access to INTEGRIS Health hospitals and ancillary services, our employed physician network and INTEGRIS Health joint venture partners.
- If we were to go out-of-network with United Healthcare, we would work with you to understand your out-of-network benefits and help you with any next steps regarding your care.
- Some patients under care with an INTEGRIS Health physician may be eligible for Continuity of Care. Please contact the number on the back of your insurance card to learn more.
- If you would like to ask United Healthcare to work with INTEGRIS Health to finalize a fair and reasonable contract, so our valued patient relationship can continue, please call (866) 801-4409. If you are with UMR (a United Healthcare company), please call (800) 826-9781.

We recognize the importance of being an in-network provider with United Healthcare. Unfortunately, the current United Healthcare payment rates do not cover our expenses due to the significant inflationary pressures we are experiencing from the increased cost of supplies, medication and labor. To date, we have been unable to secure a contract with the necessary rate increases to share some of our inflationary pressures with United Healthcare.

We are committed to working diligently for a resolution. We will communicate with you as updates are available. You can also visit <https://integrisok.com/unitedinsurance>, which will include the latest information.

Thank you for trusting INTEGRIS Health to serve your health care needs.

We are aware that United Healthcare intends to send a letter to their members starting early next week and we requested a courtesy copy of the letter to forward you once we receive a copy. Based on our experience with United from past negotiations, they may also choose to send a letter to independent physicians informing you that privileges at a United Healthcare participating facility need to be obtained before 12/6/23. At this time, we are not recommending any action from our physicians.

Please be assured that INTEGRIS Health is working diligently to come to a fair agreement with United. We have asked United to acknowledge the challenges of our increased labor demands, higher supply costs and record inflation at a time when United continues to post record-setting profits - \$5B in Q3 2023.
