Letter from the President

Dear Colleagues,

I recently listened to many fascinating talks at a convention exploring innovation and value-based care (VBC) in the United States. There is clearly a move in this country towards value in healthcare delivery. Some health systems have moved up to 65% of their Medicare patients into value-based arrangements and out of traditional Medicare. It is likely that all government payors will be utilizing ACO's and value arrangements for all their covered lives by 2030. That is only 8 years away. This will result in significant changes for health systems and physicians. The value focus moves care out of the hospital and into the ambulatory setting. Many hospital admissions will be seen as failures of the system and not as revenue streams. This will result in demand destruction on the hospital side and for some surgical services. This creates a real dilemma for the health system and the CFO's. Do you support value-based care and decrease your traditional income or stay on the fee-for-service train and risk being left behind in a changing world?

We have seen an aggressive change in payor interest in value over the last 2 years. Most negotiations in the commercial space now have a specific value component. This is a new world, and we must be prepared for it. You cannot just show up and expect to be successful.

FFS, ACO, VBC, RAF, LOS and HCC are all frequent mnemonics in the new value world. Do you have a clear understanding of all these things and how they work together? Well, you better. There are likely many things we have to unlearn as well. One of the speakers discussed untraining the physicians and health systems from their current behavior. It is really a bit hard to listen to at times. If you go below the surface and really listen to the current state of healthcare finances and what is being said it is a little easier to stomach. These discussions can really create dissonance in the physician community. It feels like a direct attack on what we have been doing all our careers.

Healthcare finances are problematic currently. There are many things that have caused this to happen not the least of which has been COVID. The industry has been changed forever and it is time to move on. It is important to remember that value-based care is not a payment model

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but, rather, a shift in focus from a capacity centric view of the world into a needs-based view. We need to be very certain that we are measuring the right things and choosing the correct metrics to make a difference. When we get that data, we need to turn it into intelligence and then action and not just charts. We must be prepared to rebuild, repair, or remodel our systems to deliver value.

I think one of the most important missions in INTEGRIS Health Partners is to provide our members with the tools and education to survive an ever-changing healthcare environment. We have committed to providing you what you will need to be successful in this value-based care experience. There will be numerous opportunities for you to learn what all of these mnemonics mean and how to use them. It will take effort and energy but nothing worthwhile is ever easy. I suspect this will be very unpleasant for some of us if not all of us as it really is a significant change.

We have been talking about the journey from fee-for-service to value since IHP was started. I truly think we will see that journey completed in the next few years. We always like to say follow the money see what the future is going to bring. Well, money is pouring into value-based care more than ever before. You must be ready to participate in this new world. The more you know the better it will be for you and your patients.

IHP has been delivering value for years - this is not a new concept for us. We have done some cool and useful things for the patients that we serve. Now we just have to understand the rules of engagement outside the smaller health plans and move our experiences and abilities into a broader area. Please stay tuned and take advantage of the many educational opportunities that will be coming throughout the next calendar year.

Insights into Palliative Care with Dr. Christine Bridges

Gardens of Gratitude

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“I want to work in my garden.” It was a hot August day and as I sat across from Mrs. Jones* at our palliative appointment. I was happy to escape the heat and enjoy the AC, but she was not so content. “I’ve always been a gardener! I won prizes with those roses. There is a lot that I can’t do right now, but if my shoulder hurt a little less, then I could pull some weeds.” She was direct and clear and always in charge of her care. I liked her very much from the moment I first met her on a busy spring day. But over the last few months the bony lesions in her scapula had increased in size and it was making gardening almost impossible. There were many people involved in her team and we agreed that radiation might help, but we knew it would not resolve the pain totally. “I don’t like pills,” she continued during our hot August visit. I had suggested pain relieving medications to her before and she knew I would suggest them again. This is often a place that I find myself with patients, where competing goals collide: I want my pain to improve so that I can garden, but I don’t want to deal with side effects of medications. Ms. Jones and I, with her kind son, spoke together about the risks and benefits of the interventions we could provide. We talked about different types of medications that could control her symptoms in different ways. Using non-opioid medications to help reduce pain and reduce the number of opioids she would need to reduce pain when needed. She eyed me carefully up and down. I smiled. “Ok, doc, I’ll try it.”

It was a good balance for Ms. Jones. She was able to tolerate radiation. She used the multi-medication strategy to address her pain. She gardened; she spent time with her grandson in that garden. This fall she brought in squash to share. This is what palliation looks like. One patient at a time. One visit, one day at a time. We know there will be more discussions, more plans to create to meet the next set of goals. Her son says thank you at each visit, expressing gratitude that between each infusion mom gets to do things that she enjoys. “Mom smiles the most digging in the dirt.” She agrees, “It’s my happy place.” I am grateful for the squash, but more grateful that Ms. Jones gets to be herself- simply a gardener- and not a patient for a few hours each week.

Oklahoma Child and Adolescent Psychiatry and Mental Health Access Program (OK-CAPMAP)

OK-CAPMAP is a pediatric psychiatry and mental health consultation service available to primary care providers, fully funded by the Oklahoma Department of Mental Health and Substance Abuse. The program aims to minimize barriers in obtaining mental health care for Oklahoma’s pediatric population through three main services for patients ages 0-21:

Psychiatry and Mental Health Consultation - Providers can call for a peer consult for diagnostic review, medication management, in-office intervention, family support, and patient advocacy. Consultation hours are 9:00 AM to 5:00 PM Monday through Friday.

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Mental Health Education and Training – In person trainings, lunch and learns, case dissections, learning library, and self-paced modules.

Mental Health Referral Assistance – Best fit local and statewide referral assistance, follow up coaching, and continuity of services.

Primary care providers play an important role in the management of behavioral healthcare for Oklahoma’s adolescents. The primary care provider is often the first or only place a patient will go to seek help. Oklahoma is categorized as a “severe shortage area in the nation” for child and adolescent psychiatrists with an average of 7 child and adolescent psychiatrists per 100,000 children and this program seeks to bridge the service area gap.

2022 Clinical Documentation Improvement Metrics – Final Deadline – Saturday, December 31st

As you know, the IHP Metric around Clinical Documentation Improvement (CDI) was changed to 1 per quarter for 2022. Due to the importance of this content as well as our hope to allow physicians every opportunity for shared savings, this deadline was extended to 3 trainings by the end of September 30, 2022, and a 4th by December 31, 2022.

Coding Tip of the Month

Hypertensive Heart & Chronic Kidney Disease

Hypertension occurring with chronic kidney disease (CKD) requires hypertension codes other than I10. The ICD-10-CM classification presumes a causal relationship between hypertension

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and kidney involvement, as the two conditions are linked by the term “with” in the ICD-10-CM Alphabetic Index.

Document and assign codes from category I12, Hypertensive chronic kidney disease, when both hypertension and CKD are present.

Use an additional code to identify the stage of CKD (N18.1-N18.6)

The ICD-10-CM classification presumes a causal relationship hypertension, kidney involvement, and heart failure.

Document and assign codes from category I13, Hypertensive heart and chronic kidney disease with or without heart failure when hypertension, CKD and heart failure are present. Use an additional code to identify the stage of CKD (N18.1-N18.6) and the type of heart failure (I50.X)

Care Continuity

In an effort to advance population health, reduce cost and duplication of services, and improve patient and provider experience, IHP is working to ensure healthcare services in the network are delivered, coordinated, and managed by in-network providers and facilities.

To do so, we have stood up the Care Continuity workstream. This program’s goal is to optimize referral decision-making and close the referral loop through:

- **Best practices and communication support** for referring and receiving providers, including strategies for building network awareness
- **HER-integrated referral tool** to empower care teams with relevant network info & referral decision support at the point of service (provider directory, search & match algorithm, tracking & reminders)
- **Data and analytics** to monitor and support continued performance improvement and identify root-cause of out-of-network referrals
