Letter from the President

Dear Colleagues,

I would like to be able to tell you that the state of medical care in the United States is in great shape, but I cannot. We are experiencing huge challenges that are financial, cultural, and systemic. The cost of doing business is increasing. Reimbursement is flat if not decreasing. Inflation is eating up everyone's paycheck. It is hard to hire staff for the office or the hospital. There is increasing demand for your time and efforts. Patients are making hard choices about how to spend their money and often are deferring needed healthcare. The news is full of stories about the financial woes of hospitals and providers. At the same time, we hear of record profits in the pharmaceutical industry and in the insurance industry. There is no wonder that we feel stressed out.

Physician burnout is influenced by all these things. Most of us went into medicine to help others and now we are faced with issues that keep us from our stated goal. At times it feels as if there is little we can do to control our own work environment. Everyone has an answer to how we can feel better. This is not just something that popped up because of the pandemic. Do a literature search about physician burnout and you can see there are many papers and seminars about this topic going back many years prior to Covid. Sometimes it all just seems overwhelming. There is a litany of new expectations, new metrics, new patient complaints, peer to peer reviews for something that you know the patient needs and many other irritants that have been appearing over the last 10 years. It is not likely any of this is going away. Recent polls tell us that the majority of patients don't think we are handling healthcare issues very well and are concerned about access to care.

I think the first thing we must do is acknowledge that these issues exist. Denial ain't a river in Egypt! We must be involved in improving the care our patients receive. If you have an opportunity to influence what is taking place in healthcare, take the time and do it. Talk to the politicians. Talk to your patients and tell them how you feel. Listen to how they feel about the state of healthcare. They have historically been our biggest supporters because we have relationships with them. I think we have gotten away from that. I have found that most patients are empathetic when they

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hear the physician's perspective. It softens the blow of long wait times and lack of staffing when we use the human touch. Remember, being affable and available are the biggest keys to success.

Doing nothing and hoping the problems will go away is not an effective strategy. This won't magically get better as Covid goes away. We did not cause all these issues, but we must help solve them. The patients depend on us to help. As I said earlier, most of us went into this profession to help people. Being aware of what is going on and advocating for patients is an important way to help. It all starts with being nice to others and taking care of yourself. The business and practice of medicine is going through difficult times. We must acknowledge this is happening and have a strategy to survive it. The problems are many and the answers are few. We are very smart people and can make this situation better if all of us work together. If we don't, who will?

2022 Clinical Documentation Improvement Metrics – Upcoming Deadline – Friday, September 30th

As you know, the IHP Metric around Clinical Documentation Improvement (CDI) was changed to 1 per quarter for 2022. Due to the importance of this content as well as our hope to allow physician's every opportunity for shared savings, this deadline has been extended to 3 trainings by the end of September 30, 2022 and a 4th by December 31, 2022.

Care Continuity

In an effort to advance population health, reduce cost and duplication of services, and improve patient and provider experience, IHP is working to ensure healthcare services in the network are delivered, coordinated, and managed by in-network providers and facilities.

To do so, we have stood up the Care Continuity workstream. This program's goal is to optimize referral decision-making and close the referral loop through:

- **Best practices and communication support** for referring and receiving providers, including strategies for building network awareness
- **HER-integrated referral tool** to empower care teams with relevant network info & referral decision support at the point of service (provider directory, search & match algorithm, tracking & reminders)
- **Data and analytics** to monitor and support continued performance improvement and identify root-cause of out-of-network referrals

Coding Tip of the Month

Heart Failure

Congestive heart failure is the mechanical inability of the heart to pump blood efficiently, thus compromising circulation and causing systemic complications due to congestion and edema.

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Heart Failure classifies to the following specified ICD-10 codes: (not all-inclusive)

I50.1 Left ventricular HF I50.22 Chronic systolic HF

I50.32 Chronic diastolic HF I50.42 Combined (diastolic/systolic) HF, chronic

I50.812 Chronic right heart failure I50.9 Congestive heart failure NOS

To validate the reporting of this condition / diagnosis accurately document the following:

- All applicable descriptors (congestive, hypertensive, acute, chronic, acute-on-chronic, diastolic, systolic, etc.)
- Signs and symptoms (edema, weight gain, shortness of breath, fatigue, etc.)
- Status (controlled by medication, stable, worsening, improving, compensated, decompensated, etc.)

Do not use the descriptor “history of” to describe current Heart Failure or Atrial Fibrillation. Per CMS “history of” implies the condition no longer exists or has resolved.

988 Suicide and Crisis Lifeline

The new nationwide 3-digit Suicide and Crisis Lifeline is now live. Callers can call or text 988 for suicidal, mental health, or substance abuse crisis in place of the previous 10-digit Suicide Prevention Lifeline. There is also an option to chat online at 988lifeline.org. If callers dial the previous Lifeline at 1-800-273-TALK, they will always be redirected to 988.

988 offers 24/7 access to trained crisis counselors. Misinformation being circulated online has many worried that they will be admitted for inpatient psychiatric care against their will if they call this number. However, the Lifeline is working as designed and most calls result in safety planning and resource referral. Studies have shown a decrease in suicidality and depressive symptoms after speaking with a Lifeline counselor. Crisis counselors will connect callers with emergency services only when necessary.

This new Lifeline is an easier to remember number for patients and expands on the existing network of resources. It helps to divert mental health crises from police departments to trained crisis counselors, resulting in better outcomes for patients.

Medications with Non-diabetes Indications for Patients with or without Type 2 Diabetes Mellitus

- **Purpose:** Awareness of FDA-Approved and off-label indications for select SGLT-2 inhibitors and GLP-1 receptor agonists
- **Cost:** Perform patient-specific affordability assessment and cost vs. benefit evaluation due to outcomes data accumulation
- **Dosage:** Caution with indication-specific dosage for each agent

***Indications in Patients WITHOUT Type 2 Diabetes:**

Heart failure (HF): Invokana, Farxiga and Jardiance’s reduction in heart failure hospitalizations and HF-related cardiovascular mortality applies when combined with guideline-directed triple therapy as tolerated (B-blocker, aldosterone antagonist, and renin-angiotensin-system agent)

Chronic kidney disease (CKD): Farxiga’s eGFR decline and end stage renal disease risk reduction is FDA approved whereas Jardiance use is currently off-label for CKD risk reduction with evidence mounting

Chronic weight management: Saxenda and Wegovy are high-dose formulations of T2DM indicated liraglutide (Victoza) and semaglutide (Ozempic). For BMI 27-30 kg/m² at least one weight-related comorbid condition is required (e.g., hypertension, type 2 diabetes mellitus, or dyslipidemia). No additional condition required if BMI 30 kg/m² or higher. **Patient education plus careful dose titration is necessary to avoid severe gastrointestinal intolerance.**

NOTE: Low-dose GLP-1 RA formulations for type 2 DM Adlyxin, Bydureon, Ozempic, Rybelsus, Trulicity, Victoza require step therapy. Weight loss avg ~3 kg if dietary and physical activity recommendations followed. Minimize GI intolerance with patient education and dose titration.

¥ Indications in Patients WITH Type 2 Diabetes:

Atherosclerotic Cardiovascular Disease (ASCVD): Risk reduction of major cardiovascular events (cardiovascular death, nonfatal myocardial infarction, and nonfatal stroke) in adults with type 2 diabetes mellitus and established cardiovascular disease (**NOTE: Rybelsus does not yet have this indication**)

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CKD: Invokana's CKD risk reduction indication is limited to patients with diabetic nephropathy.
